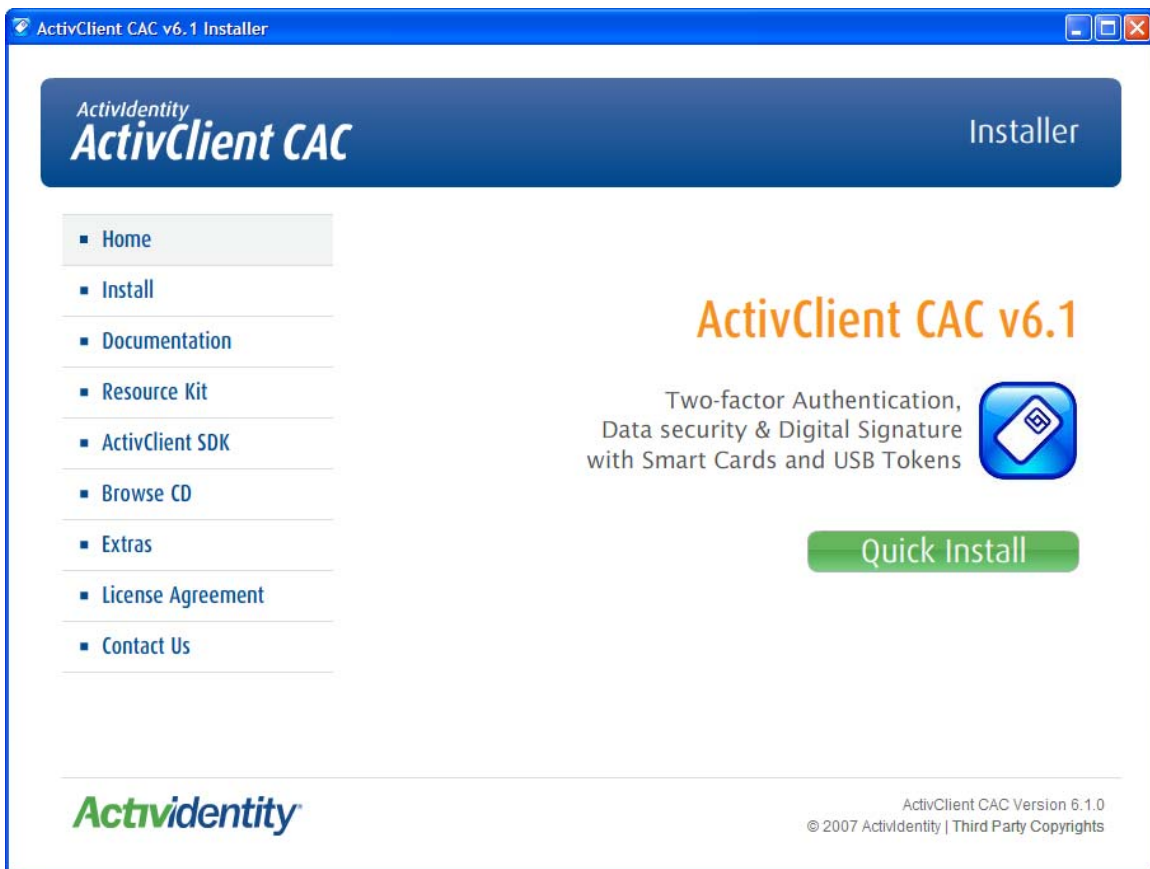
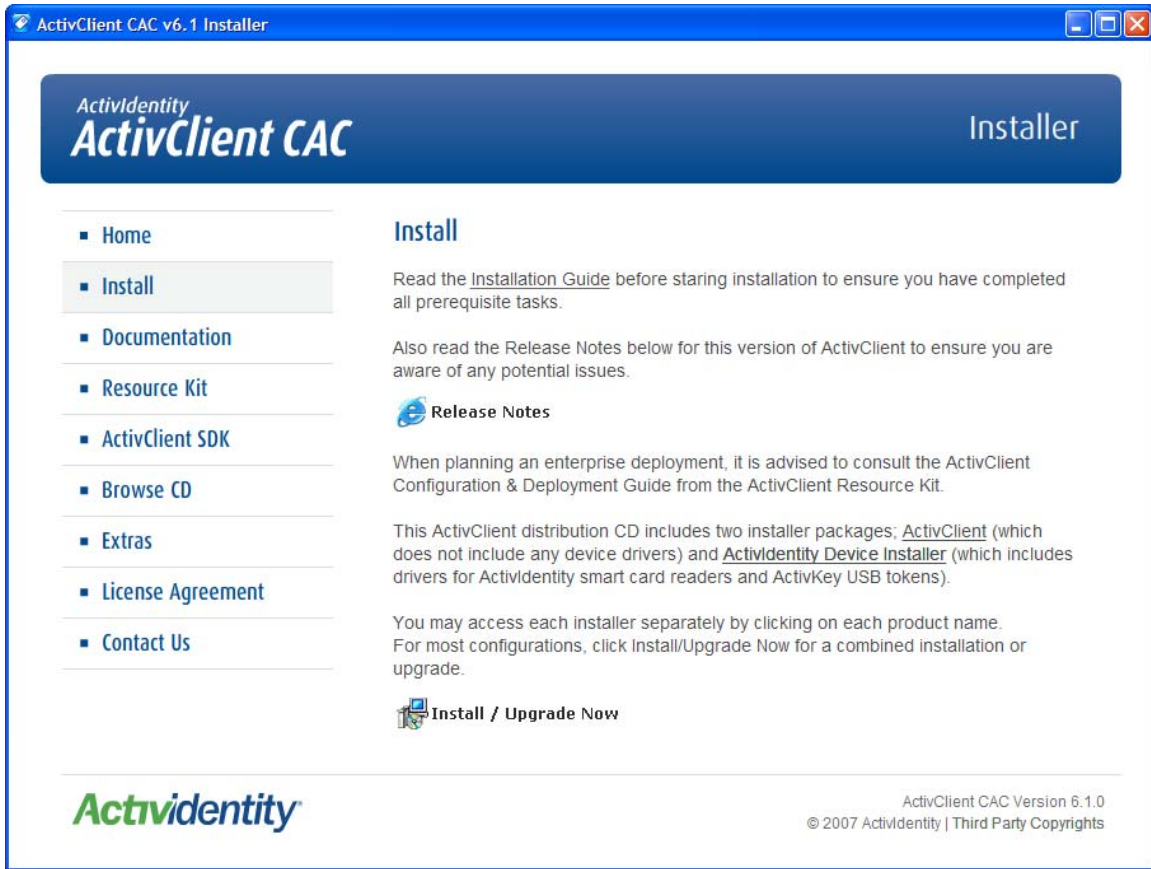


ActivClient 6.1 Installation on a Home PC

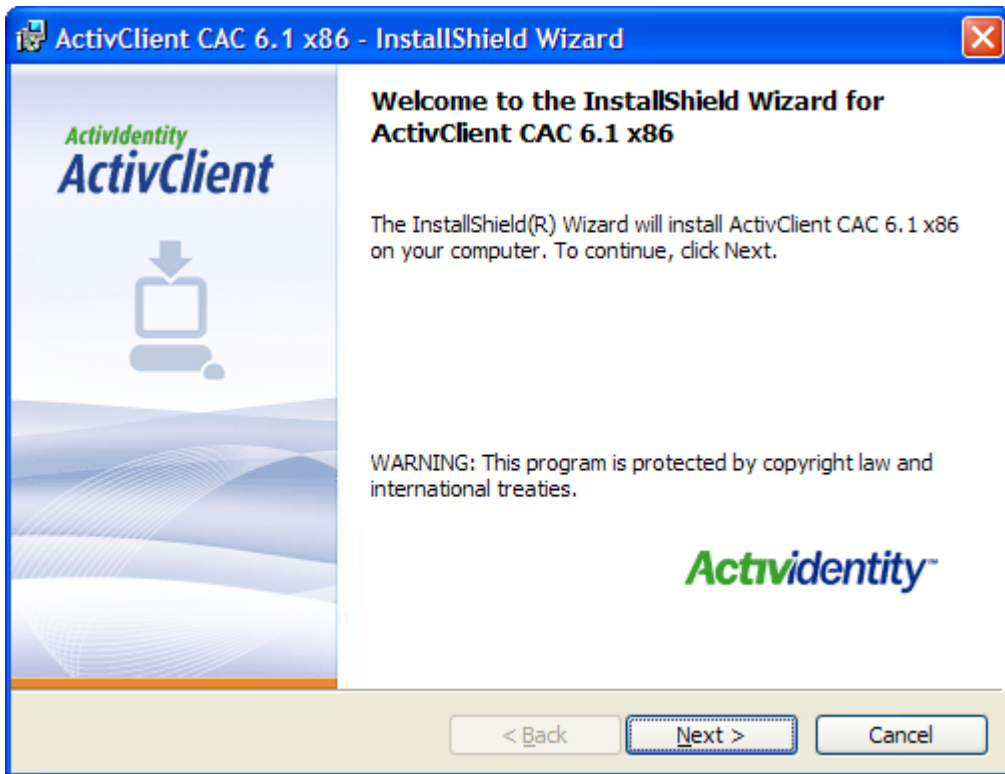
Double click the "start.exe" file. The installer window will appear.



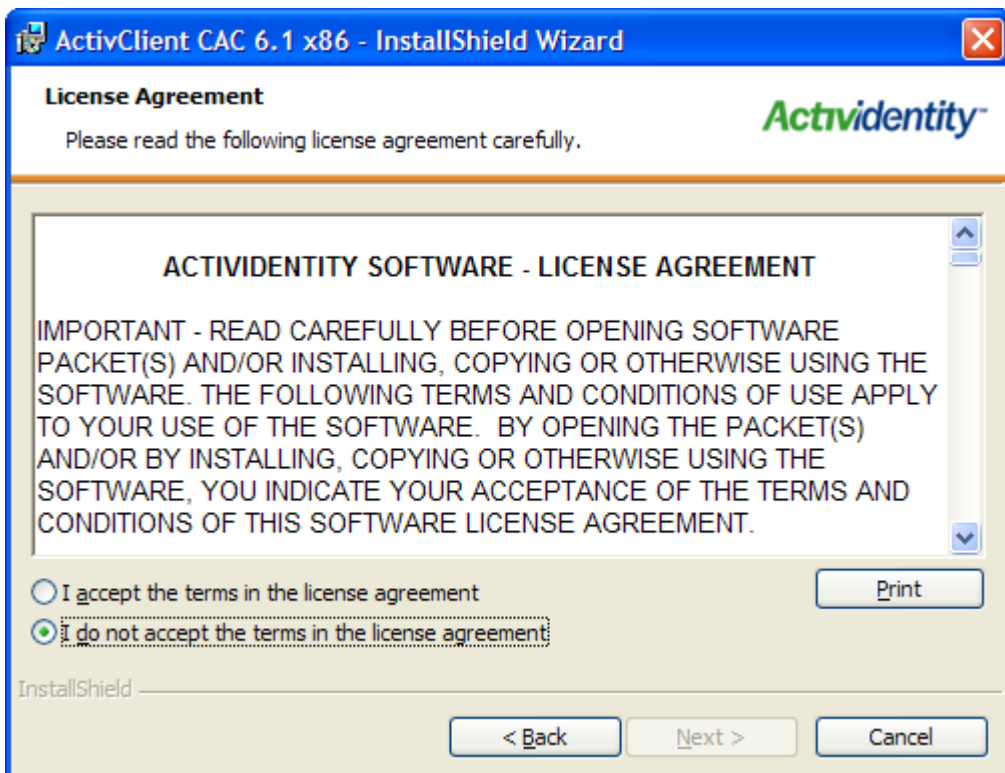
Click "Install" in the list on the left. The Installer start page will appear.



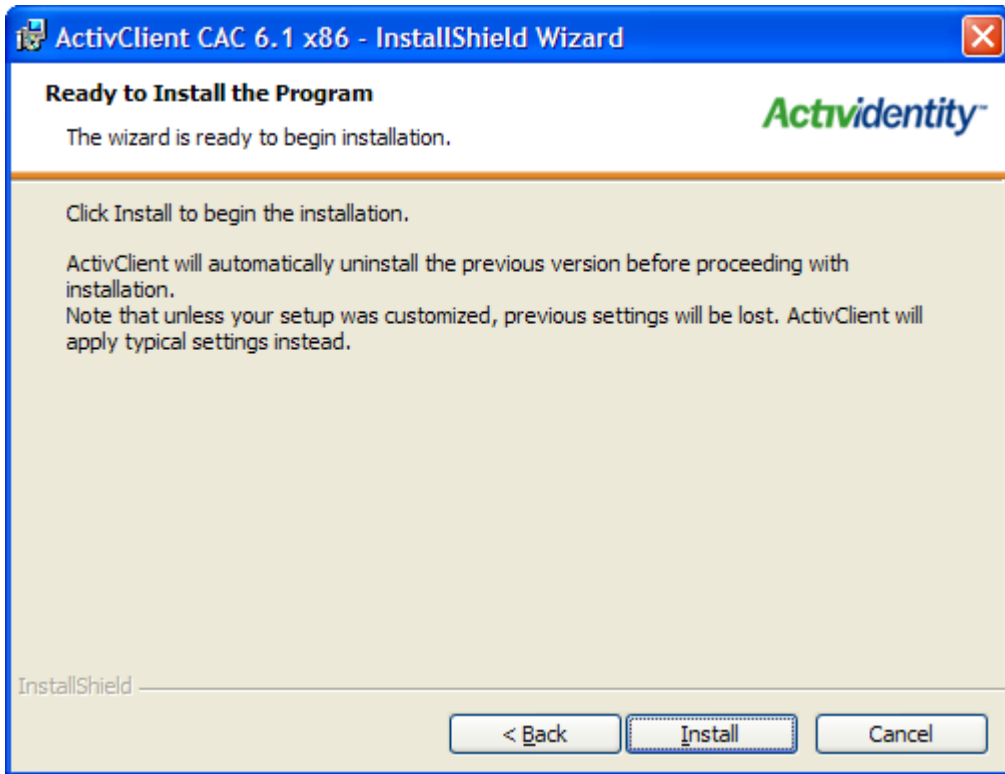
Click "Install/Upgrade Now" at the bottom of the screen. Several brief preparation windows will appear then the "Welcome" window will appear.



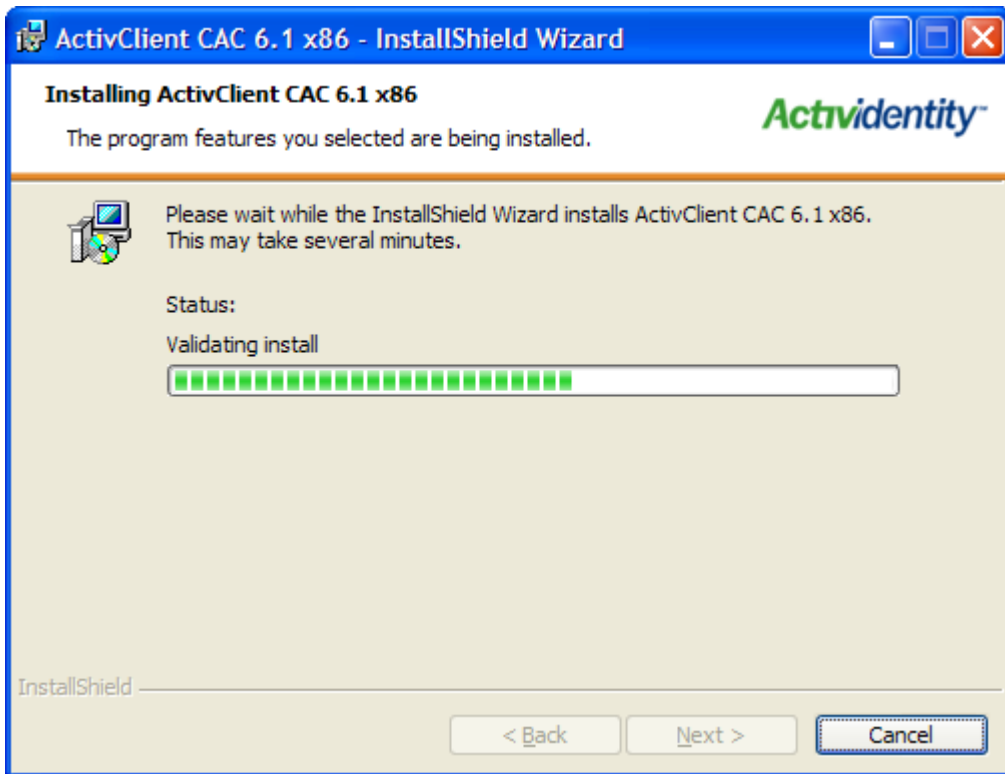
Click "Next". The License Agreement window will appear.



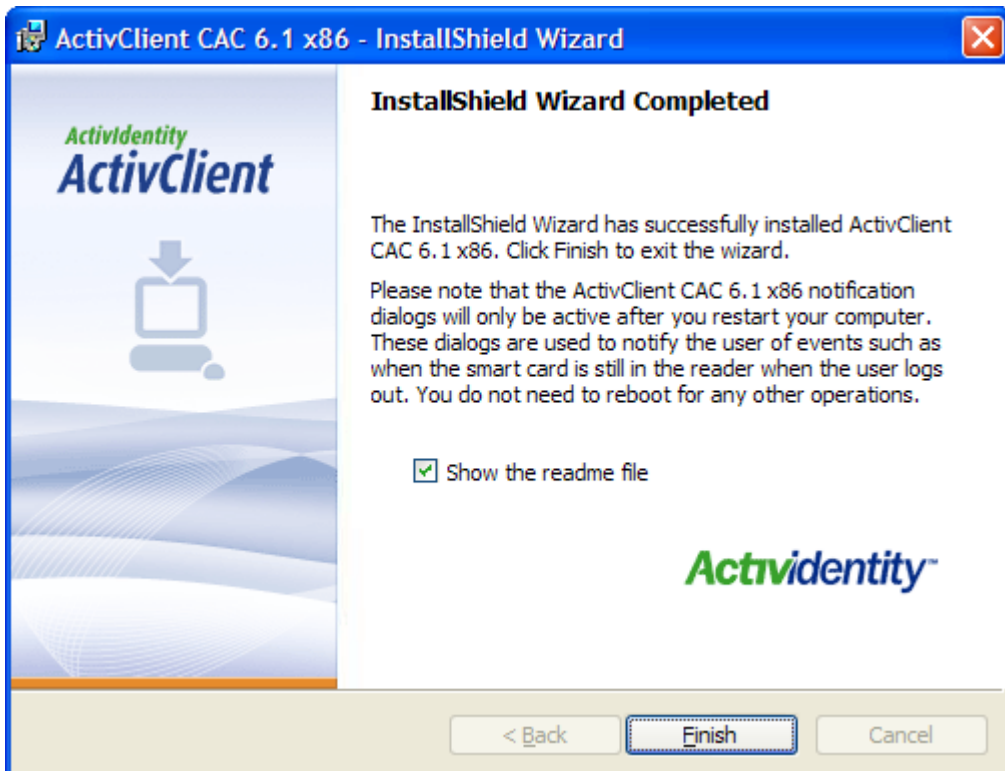
Click the "I accept..." bullet. This will make "Next" available. Click Next. The Ready to Install window will appear.



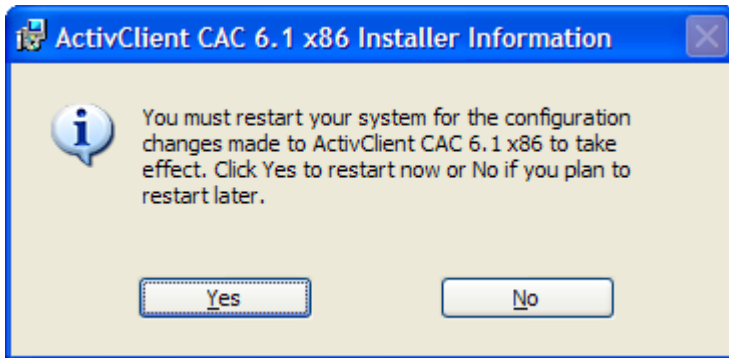
Click "Install". The InstallShield Wizard window will appear.



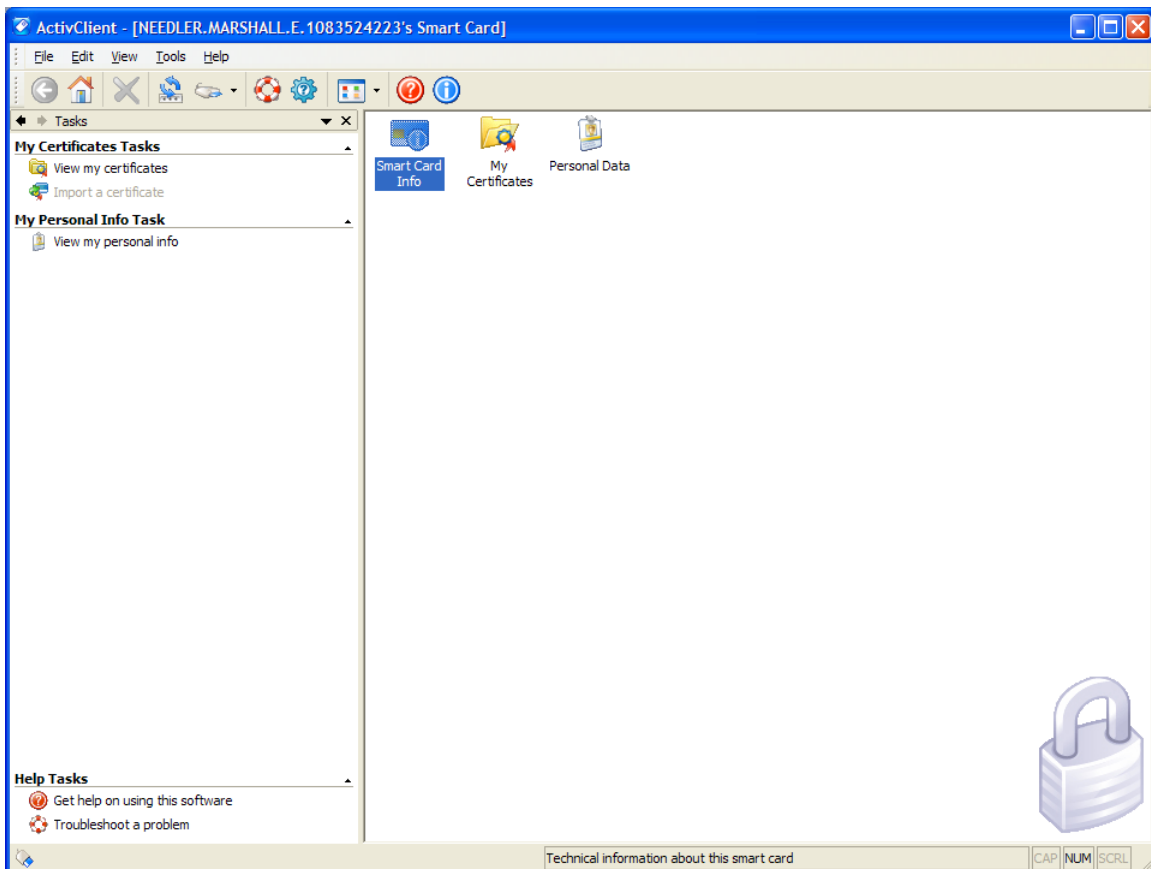
The installation may take a few minutes. Wait as it finishes. When the installation is completed, the InstallShield Wizard Completed window will appear.



Unless you really want to view the Readme file, uncheck the "Show the readme file" box and then click "Finish". You very likely will be prompted to restart the PC.



Click "Yes". Once the PC is ready and you've logged in to Windows or your network, go to the ActivClient Agent icon in the Windows startup tray at the bottom right of your screen and double click it. The ActivClient window will open.



If your reader (hardware) has been detected by ActivClient, you should see your name at the top of the ActivClient window with your CAC ID. Go to Tools > Advanced > Make Certificates Available to Windows. Once the certificates have been detected and configured, you should see the ActivClient Make certificate available" window.



You should see three separate certificates as displayed above. Click OK. Go to File > Use Reader. You should see your CAC reader listed there. If for some reason you have more than one reader on the PC, all readers should be listed, but you'll need to select the one that you want ActivClient to use. Close ActivClient.
